Features include fault identification, shield detection, split-pair identification, voltage detection, tone generation and support for up to 16 remote IDs. CuBLU II and CuBLU III also add cable length and resistance measurements, while CuBLU III includes passive PoE detection for safer testing around powered Ethernet ports.

The UniBLU app allows users to save, review and export test results directly from the field, creating a more efficient and professional workflow.

Wiremap Testing & Shield Detection

CuBLU performs wiremap testing across all eight conductors while also verifying cable shielding. This helps technicians quickly identify wiring faults before cables are patched, commissioned or handed over.



Rechargeable 96-Hour Battery

With up to 96 hours of runtime and convenient USB-C charging, CuBLU is designed for long workdays, multi-day projects and installation teams that cannot afford unnecessary downtime.



Resistance and Length Measurement

CuBLU II and CuBLU III add cable length measurements of up to 120 metres and DC resistance measurements per pair. These capabilities extend testing beyond simple pass/fail verification, providing technicians with more detailed information for troubleshooting and cable validation.



Colour TFT LCD

Unlike many low-cost testers that rely on basic monochrome displays, CuBLU features a colour TFT LCD for improved visibility. Results are easier to read, interpret and act upon during installation and troubleshooting.



PoE Detection

CuBLU III provides passive PoE detection, allowing technicians to identify powered Ethernet ports before testing or connection. Because detection is passive and non-disruptive, it is ideal for live network environments where connected devices should not be interrupted.



UniBLU App-Based Documentation

CuBLU II and CuBLU III connect to the UniBLU app, allowing technicians to save, document and export test results directly from the field. This improves traceability, simplifies documentation and supports a more professional project handover.



Complete Fault Diagnosis

CuBLU identifies six common fault types, including open, short, miswire, crossover, split pair and multi-fault conditions. This provides technicians with more detailed fault information than a simple pass/fail result, reducing troubleshooting time and helping identify problems more quickly.



Up to 16 Remote IDs

CuBLU supports up to 16 remote IDs, with the selected remote number clearly displayed on the screen. This helps installers identify and verify multiple cable runs more efficiently across rooms, racks and patch panels.



Automatic Cable Recognition

The UniBLU app automatically identifies the cable type under test, including coax, RG11/12, single-pair and customised wire configurations. Matching connection diagrams and pass/fail criteria provide clearer results and more accurate documentation.



Cable Tracing

Seven selectable tone frequencies help technicians trace cables through bundles, walls, racks and patching areas. Compatible with standard toner probes, CuBLU makes cable identification faster and easier during installation and troubleshooting.



Voltage Detection

CuBLU detects AC/DC voltage before connection, helping protect technicians from live cables in the field. This is particularly useful in environments where low-voltage cabling and electrical wiring are installed alongside one another.

Structured Cabling Installations

CuBLU is ideal for CAT5e, CAT6 and CAT6A installation and verification in offices, commercial buildings, warehouses and campus environments.

It gives installation teams a practical way to verify cable runs, identify common wiring faults and confirm cable identity before handover. Support for up to 16 remote IDs also improves productivity when working across multiple drops, patch panels and telecommunications rooms.



Smart Buildings, Security and AV

Modern buildings rely heavily on copper cabling to support IP cameras, access control systems, displays, sensors and AV equipment.

CuBLU is well suited to these environments because it combines wiremap testing, cable tracing, voltage detection and, with CuBLU III, passive PoE detection. App-based documentation also supports the traceability requirements of smart building and AV installations.



Data Centres

Data centres demand accurate labelling, disciplined cabling practices and rapid fault isolation.

CuBLU supports day-to-day verification tasks by helping technicians identify wiring faults, trace cable runs, verify remote IDs and detect voltage before connection. It's particularly useful for moves, adds and changes, rack-level checks and routine troubleshooting.



Electrical and Low-Voltage Installers

As electrical contractors increasingly take on data cabling, smart building and low-voltage installations, they need tools that provide more capability than a basic continuity tester.

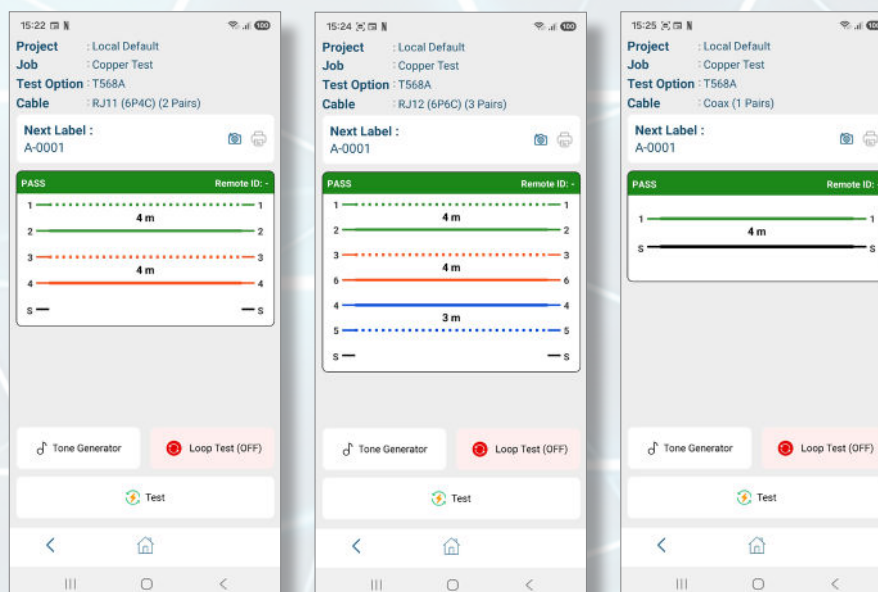
